Do you know that the average attendance of our Sunday School is around 400, or 40% of the estimated 1,000 people that attend the Lord's Day services on Sunday? This makes it one of the biggest ministries in the church.

Our motto in the Sunday School is that we have a class for every age, from the youngest at 3 years old to the oldest in the Adults Department, some of our students are into their seventies! Probably hundreds have gone through the Sunday School growing up in church, and many of our Session members today were once or are still Sunday school teachers today. It is thus no accident that we take the effort every year to share with one and all about the Sunday School.

Today we would like to share with you more about the Senior Department of the Sunday School.

The Senior Department comprises 9 classes and caters to people between the ages of 17 and 23, i.e. from JC1 / Poly, through to Army and all the way to at least halfway through tertiary education. We have a total of 16 teachers and an average attendance of 65 - 75 students each week.

This year, our theme is "Cultivating Godly Characteristics to the Glory of God". One of the dangers of being in a reformed and conservative church is that one tends to be only filled with head knowledge. How often it is lamented that we have all the right answers and know all the hard doctrines of the Christian faith, but find ourselves sorely lacking in the softer side of Christian living and in our individual areas of testimony.

The challenge for the Senior Department this year is to equip ourselves with godly characteristics that the Apostle Peter speaks of in 2 Peter 1:3-8. The Bible tells us that if we cultivate these characteristics, we will be neither barren nor unfruitful, and we will never be shaken.

We warmly invite you to join us every Sunday as we study the Word of God together.
