Adult Bible Classes

The apostle Paul exhorts younger believers to be discipled by mature believers (2 Tim 2:2; Titus 2:1-5) through the study of God's Word. Hence, the Adult department of Sunday School encourages new believers to start with the *Basic Bible Course*, and then move on to *Growing in the Faith*.

I. Basic Bible Course. This class is designed for seekers of the truth and young believers.
