The children begin their Sunday School Day with songs led and taught by Sister Phoebe and teachers.






Pre-Nursery (2-3 years old) - FEK Room 1

In Life Bible-Presbyterian Church, there is an unofficial tagline for the Sunday School, "There is a Sunday School Class for every age."

Indeed, whether you are a male or female adult, a teenager or a school-going child, you can be assured that there is a suitable Sunday School class awaiting you every Lord's Day. Likewise, for the little ones who are between 18 months old and three years old, there is a *Pre-Nursery Sunday School Class* waiting for them with wide, open arms.

For every Christian parent, we are all girded with this sound advice from Proverbs 22:6, "Train up a child in the way that he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it." And by God's grace and enabling, that's exactly what the Pre-Nursery Sunday School Class sets out to do—to train and nurture the little ones to pray to Jesus and to do only those things that He would be happy with. We pray and hope that this lofty objective has been met—even in the slightest way—through the activities below:

By the ringing of a bell and with the earnest call of the big sisters (Sisters Joy Wong, Heidi Ho, Tabitha Heah, Eunice Yeo and Grace Lim), the little ones will begin with a time of singing praises to the Lord.

After the little ones are made excited (and hopefully more awake too) with the singing, one of the big sisters or Aunty Tan Ling Ling, Fiona Lee or Rhoda Lim will tell them a bible story. Through the telling of the bible story, we pray and hope that the little ones will take with them at least one lesson about God: that God made the first man and woman, that Jesus is mighty and powerful to heal the sick, and most of all, Jesus died on the cross for their sins.

To help reinforce the bible story they have just heard, the little ones will have a time of pasting stickers and doodling with any colour pencil on the art-and-craft handout intended just for the bible lesson they have learned.

So if your child falls within this age group of 18 months − 3 years old, we urge you to bring your child to join us on every Lord's Day, 9.30am, at FEK Room 1. Not sure where FEK Room 1 is? Well, just find your way to the classroom with toddlers making the typical joyful noise, "I Want My Mummy!".
