## XIX The Law of God, Westminster Confession of Faith

*“V. The moral law [The Ten Commandments] does forever bind all, as well justified persons as others, to the obedience thereof; and that, not only in regard of the matter contained in it, but also in respect of the authority of God the Creator, who gave it. <b>S/No</b>	<b>Ten Commandments</b>	<b>Comment</b>
5th	Honour your father and mother.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• “Honour” means high respect.</li><li>• They must be respected and obeyed while under the parents’ direct authority in the home prior to a young person’s marriage (Gen 2:24).</li><li>• We obey our parents as long as it’s consistent with God’s teachings.</li><li>• Many do not have good relations with their parents. Nagging parents, etc. (Share).</li></ul>

<b>S/No</b>	<b>Ten Commandments</b>	<b>Comment</b>
5th	Honour your father and mother.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Parents are protective over their children eg. Not to mix with wrong company and engage in criminal activities, drugs, vices.</li><li>• Naturally, obeying parents would typically lead to a healthier life and longer life span.</li></ul>

6th	You shall not murder.	<p><b>Exodus 20:13</b> <sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.</p> <p><b>Matthew 5:21-22</b> <sup>21</sup> Ye have heard that it was said of them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment:</p> <p><sup>22</sup> But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.</p>

S/No	Ten Commandments	Comment
6th	You shall not murder.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We must not take the life of another person by murder.</li> <li>• Man is made in God’s image and must be protected.</li> <li>• Christ extended in Matt 5:21-22: Anger towards someone is also wrong.</li> <li>• We must restrain our anger or not allude to another person as “ a fool”.</li> <li>• <u>God looks at the act and the attitude in the heart.</u></li> <li>• Don’t: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) be angry without a cause,</li> <li>(b) condemn,</li> <li>(c) hate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

7th	Do not commit adultery.	<p data-bbox="1039 249 1447 307"><b>Exodus 20:14</b></p> <p data-bbox="1039 335 2068 399">14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.</p> <p data-bbox="1039 514 1574 571"><b>Matthew 5:27-28</b></p> <p data-bbox="1039 599 2344 749">27 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery:</p> <p data-bbox="1039 863 2407 1106">28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.</p>



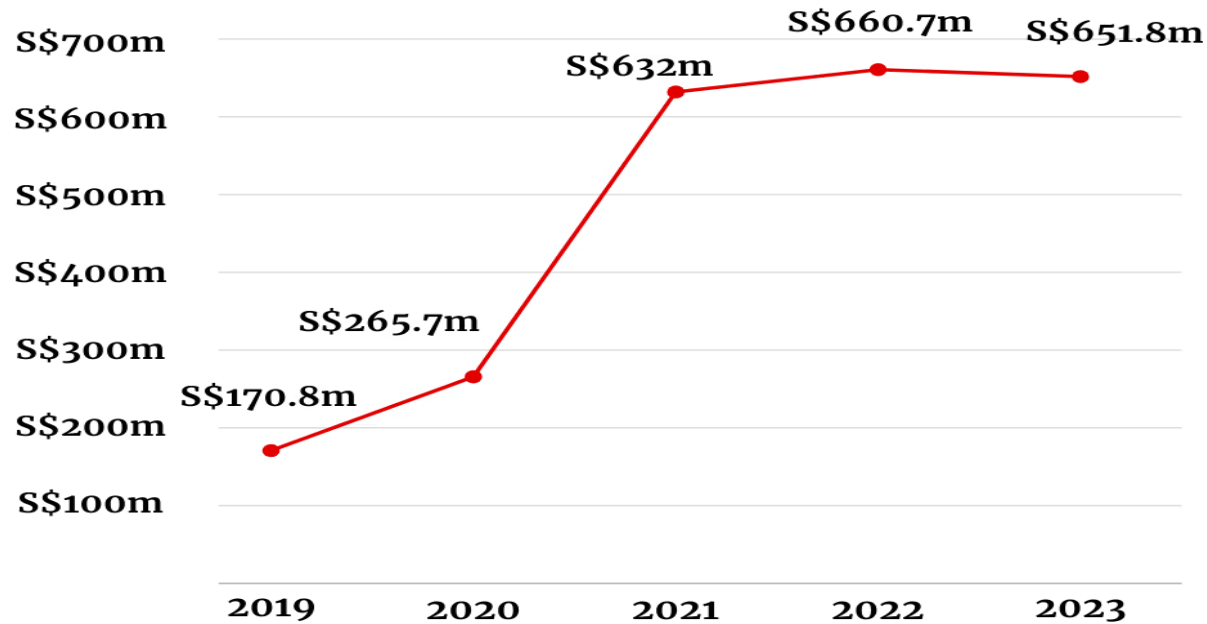
<b>S/No</b>	<b>Ten Commandments</b>	<b>Comment</b>
7th	Do not commit adultery.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The marital vow is a holy commitment and not to be violated by sexual unfaithfulness under any circumstances.</li><li>• There are serious repercussions for adultery eg King David.</li><li>• Christ extended in Matt 5:27-28</li><li>• Lust</li><li>• Hidden persuaders – e.g. uncensored movies on the internet and in-flight, liberal lifestyles, etc.</li></ul>

<b>S/No</b>	<b>Ten Commandments</b>	<b>Comment</b>
7th	Do not commit adultery.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) mistress, girlfriend, boyfriend if married</li><li>(b) inappropriate behaviour before marriage</li><li>(c) cohabitation,</li><li>(c) multiple partners,</li><li>(d) pornography</li></ul></li> <li>• Breakup of families</li><li>• Unwanted pregnancy</li><li>• Delinquent children</li></ul>

8th	You shall not steal.	<p data-bbox="1039 248 1447 305"><b>Exodus 20:15</b></p> <p data-bbox="1039 334 1717 391"><sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.</p> <p data-bbox="1039 519 1498 576"><b>Ephesians 4:28</b></p> <p data-bbox="1039 605 2405 919"><sup>28</sup> Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.</p>

8th	You shall not steal.	• Example: Shop theft, scammers, plagiarism.

8th	You shall not steal.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Common : (a) office stationery items, (b) laptop and other IT equipment/accessories</li><li>• Do not keep things belonging to your employer or someone else.</li><li>• Finders keepers?</li><li>• Steal ideas and hard work of others by claiming them as your own.</li></ul>

9th	You shall not give false witness.	<p><b>Exodus 20:16</b> <sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.</p> <p><b>Colossians 3:9</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <sup>9</sup> Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;</li></ul>

10th	You shall not covet.	<b>Exodus 20:17</b> <sup>17</sup> Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
